This year, South Texas College is celebrating the 25 year anniversary of its Dual Credit Programs. STC is a national leader in dual credit and the program's regional success is undeniable.

To date, 145,000 students have gone through the program and earned college credit even before graduating high school and parents of dual credit students have saved \$425 million in tuition fees.

Almost one third of the STC enrollment of 30,000 is made up of Dual Credit students making STC one of the largest colleges in Texas and one of the most prominent community colleges in the nation.

STC remains the top producer of nurses in the state and the only community college in Texas to offer five baccalaureate degrees.

With more than 130 degrees and certificate program options in fields of study including business, technology, liberal arts, social science, math and nursing and allied health, South Texas College is committed to a bold vision, innovative solutions and creative partnerships that will bring more opportunities to our students and, in turn, the region.
